**4th of July Parade:** The 4th of July Parade is happening again this year! If you'd like to

participate, Jim Franck has generously offered to let us use his property as the staging ground. Please take your float, wagon, or fancy car to the far end of Blue Heron Road by noon, where the Parade Marshals, Kathleen & Thor Albro, will organize participants. **The parade begins at 1 pm;** the route is the lower portion of Blue Heron Road. **Public parking is not available this year**, so if you plan to drive to Blue Heron, arrange with a homeowner to park on their property. **All vehicles must be down the hill by 12:30.** Traffic will be redirected after this time. If you have guests arriving or run a short-term rental, please inform them of the road restrictions. The volunteer fire department will have an aid rig at the west end of Blue Heron Road and a roving response cyclist.

There's still time to join the **Samish Island Marching Band** (always a parade highlight). Rehearsal is at 7 pm at the Community Center on **Wed., July 3<sup>rd</sup>.** New members are always welcome. Music will be available. Or....just show up at noon on the 4<sup>th</sup> with instrument in hand!


