SICC is proud to host a series of three concerts at the community center in **March, April, and May**.

Sunday, March 8th: **Pearl Django** is a jazz group established in 1994 in Tacoma and melds the music of Django Reinhardt and Stephane Grappelli with American Swing. They play traditional jazz classics and original compositions and are among the most highly regarded gypsy jazz groups working today.

Sunday, April 19th: **Gallowglass** is an acoustic Irish band that interprets traditional and contemporary Celtic folk music, with a focus on vocal harmonies, unique instrumentation, and compelling arrangements. They'll bring the Community center alive with centuries-old, richly emotive music.

Sunday, May 3rd: **Corazones de Cedro** brings the centuries-old vibrant musical tradition of Son Jarocho—blending Indigenous, Spanish, and West African roots—from the Gulf Coast of Mexico to WA with performances that are rhythmically sophisticated and completely engaging.

We gather at **10 am** for coffee and conversation, our meeting begins at **10:30** with announcements, followed by the program presented by island resident **Nick Hagan**.
